- The book list will be e-mailed and it contains all the books chosen as of the date it is released. However, all tutors and administration reserve the right to add titles later in the summer or during the year.
- CHA will be taking orders only for those titles on the Order sheet. See below for more information on where to order. Pricing at [www.amazon.com](http://www.amazon.com) and Rainbow Resource are provided for comparison.
- Unfortunately, we were not able to resolve the customer service issues with Borders. Therefore, we do not have an ordering agreement with them this year.
- By placing an order through CHA you agree to the following
  - There is a \$25 returned check fee
  - No add-ons after orders are submitted
  - No refunds on opened merchandise or if you decide not to attend the academy (We will try to assist you in selling your books if a family is taking your place)

  - **one spreadsheet for each grade in which you have a child**
  - an **optional Parents'** books spreadsheet
  - **Grades 6-12** may have separate **Spanish, Latin, Grammar,** and/or **Math** spreadsheets (class lists will be distributed) \*\*. See spreadsheets for grades to see if this applies to your family. **Logic** books are on class lists.
  - **An order sheet if needed (first spreadsheet in file)**
  - Please review lists carefully, especially for **optional** books **and titles on more than one spreadsheet** (ie. You only need one Kingfisher Encyclopedia per family).
- Please use a pen and mark your order clearly. Do not use a highlighter since we will be copying the order sheets. Please **make a copy** of your order for yourself before submitting so that you will know what has been ordered.

- Grade-specific issues
  - **All grades:** Booklists include all titles that are confirmed. Titles may be added at a later date in any class.
  - **Grade 3-5:** Be sure to get Shurley **CLASSROOM** edition if you purchase this on your own; 5<sup>th</sup> grade uses Shurley 6.
  - **Grade 3-8:** All families need one IEW handbook per family
  - **Grade 4: Special Wonders** Feathered Friends, Wild Kingdom and Sea World are now published as Breathtaking Birds, Magnificent Mammals and Sensational Sea Creatures, respectively. You may purchase either the Special Wonder titles (used) or the new titles.
  - **Grade 5-8:** Each family needs one copy of Kingfisher Encyclopedia of History.
  - **Grade 5-11:** Each student needs one Timeline. You may print the emailed file.
  - **Grade 5:** The designated publisher of Famous Men of Rome and Famous Men of Greece is Greenleaf. Please be sure you are purchasing a **Greenleaf** edition.
  - **Grade 5:** Hadasseh, The Girl Who Became Queen Esther is out of print. Fill in on CHA order sheet if needed so we can arrange to get you a copy.

- **Saxon 7/6 Math:** Current students are using their books this summer. We will put out a list of families willing to sell their copies when they are finished.
- **Grade 10 and 11:** Exploring Creation books should be **2<sup>nd</sup> edition**; Please note Rainbow Resource has the best price.
- **Grade 11:** You may wish to purchase The Research book used from a senior in January when they are finished with it.
- **Grade 9-12:** IEW Handbook (1/family) is **recommended**
- **Grade 9-11:** There is a new edition (7<sup>th</sup>) of the MLA Handbook out which should be purchased.
- **Grade 9-12:** Great Books lists consist of the preferred edition/translation of the tutors. We recommend that you purchase these editions. If you choose to use different editions there may be some difficulties following along in class.
